Complete permit application and return it to the City Clerk's Office along with:

- One Application per pet or up to 5 chickens
- Letter of permission from the landlord
- Letters from building residents / neighbors indicating knowledge of the exotic pet
- * Ferrets must have current rabies vaccination certificate to file with the application

Once the application is completed, along with supporting documents a home inspection will be conducted prior to submitting the application to Common Council.

If Common Council approves the application, applicant must provide the fee and then the permit will be mailed out to the applicant.

If the application is denied, there is no fee.

Permits are issued for a calendar year, and are renewable each January. Renewal notices are sent out a month before.
