2017 Cortland Junior Police Academy Information Sheet

The Cortland Police Department will be holding its Junior Police Academy from July 31st through August 11th, 2017. This year's Academy will again be held at the former NYS Armory located on Wheeler Avenue in the City of Cortland.

Enrollment for the Academy will be restricted to 20 recruits. All applicants must be entering 9th through 12th grade. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. The first 20 applications received will determine who is accepted to this year's recruit class. Any applications received after the first 20 will be placed on a waiting list. If any of the first 20 applicants decide not to participate, the waiting list will then be used to fill any openings. The waiting list will also function on a first come, first served basis. All returned applications and attached waivers/releases must be filled out completely.

Any application returned that is not filled out completely or as instructed will be subject to disqualification.

Our objective is a week of education and fun through a Police Academy format. The two week long curriculum will include various presentations from guest law enforcement agencies, hands-on practices and physical training to give the students an idea of what is involved in becoming a Police Officer.

The Junior Police Academy will culminate in a graduation ceremony. Each cadet's family is invited and encouraged to attend the ceremony. The daily schedule is from 8:00am to 3:30pm.

Recruits are to be dropped off at the NYS Armory no later than 7:45 a.m. on each day.

Transportation to and from the Academy is the responsibility of the recruit's parent or guardian. Please be prompt when dropping off and picking up your children.

We are hopeful that the interaction that will take place between your children and the members of our police department will have a positive effect on all involved. As police officers, we thoroughly enjoy participating in these programs and look forward to working with your children.

There is a **\$100.00 fee per child** for participation in the Cortland Junior Police Academy. This fee covers the cost of the Police Academy uniforms, 10 days of events, supplies, field trips costs, academy graduation and the graduation ceremony programs. A check made payable to **Cortland Police Department** must be submitted with the application. **NO CASH will be accepted.** Applications without payment will be rejected. There will be no refunds after July 12, 2017 at 9:00am. No refunds will be provided for any child expelled from the program due to a violation of the academy rules. Any child that is rejected or not accepted into the program will be refunded the initial application fee.

Cortland Junior Police Academy Application

The academy will simulate actual law enforcement training. It will also expose positive, risk-reduction activities to decrease the prevalence and initiation of drug and alcohol use among our Cortland youth. The Cadet will learn laws and rules that apply to various situations that Cortland Police Officers may deal with on a regular basis. The Cadet will be put through classroom instruction followed by actual role plays that will give the teen an opportunity to experience situations that police officers face every day. It is our hope that the teen will better understand law enforcement while learning good decision making skills.

The academy will last two weeks and will be held at the former NYS National Guard Armory located on Wheeler Avenue in the city of Cortland. The schedule will consist of daily physical training (running and modified police academy exercises), classroom instruction and scenario training. Students will receive a ball cap, 2 t-shirts, 2 polos, 2 shorts, a belt and a pair of pants. We require that the Cadet wear athletic sneakers and white ankle socks every day (not provided). The academy will start at 8:00am and end at 3:30pm. Teens will be given a lunch break every afternoon. Meals not provided.
