FORMS – Registration forms are available at the Cortland Youth Bureau office, Cortland Teen Center, Cortland Elementary School offices and accessible at www.cortland.org/youth during registration periods. If a program requires a participant to register, the registration must be returned to the Cortland Youth Bureau or Teen Center, unless stated otherwise. Families with 3 or more children will not pay more than \$120.00 per year for Youth Bureau programs (prices only pertain to in-house sponsored programs, not including field trips).

BE AN EARLY BIRD – If you would like to participate in one of our programs, please register well in advance of the registration deadline. If the program has reached the maximum enrollment, your name will be placed on a waiting list. You will be notified by phone of any openings. ****If registration form is turned in after deadline, there will be an additional \$5.00 late fee****

Jim Partigianoni Scholarship Fund:

Scholarships are available for resident individuals of all ages, who, for financial reasons, would otherwise be unable to participate in Cortland Youth Bureau programs. Scholarships apply only to in-house sponsored programs, not including field trips. Interested individuals should contact our office at 753-3021 or pick-up a scholarship form at the Youth Bureau office.

Reservations:

Reservations must be completed for picnic facilities, buildings, fields and the showmobile by filling out the reservation forms at the Cortland Youth Bureau office.

For your outdoor event, consider one of the Youth Bureau’s picnic facilities:

Yaman Park, Suggett Park Shelters:

- Accommodate 100 – 150 people
- Equipped with tables, grills and rest room facilities
- Prices for shelters and building rentals are \$50.00

***Security Deposit of \$100.00 required for Burch Building.**

Dexter Park, Beaudry Park, and cabanas at Yaman Park:

- Smaller Shelters
- Used on first-come, first serve basis

Organized leagues and tournaments have first preference in the use of ball fields.

There is a cost for field reservation for benefit games.

Yaman Park Bus Fee: \$40.00 – entrance park
(Cortland City Schools are exempt)

Gym Reservations – County Office Building:

Located off Greenbush St., this facility is available for recreational use, mainly basketball and volleyball. Reservations must be made through the City Youth Bureau office by responsible individuals at least 21 years of age. Cost: \$20.00 for a two hour time slot, \$25.00 for advance reservation.
